CREATION CARE NOTE—Most of the cost of using dryers is the energy it takes to heat the air. If you hang your close outside to dry in the summer and the wind isn't cooperating, run the clothes through your dryer's air cycle first - it softens the wrinkles. In winter, use the air cycle before hanging the clothes on racks, collapsible clothes trees, or other support. This will also add moisture to our dry winter air.
